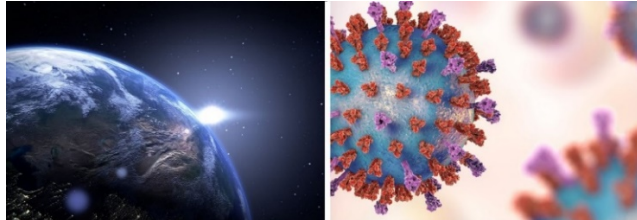


All in the Family: COVID-19 Impact on Cross-Border Marriage, Divorce and Custody
